

Loreto students excel

LORETO Normanhurst students achieved excellent results in the 2018 HSC.

Daniella Bianchi (studies of religion II) and Angelina Gu (modern history) came first in their course.

Daniella also achieved the school's top ATAR of 99.15 making her the dux of 2018.

Nine Loreto Normanhurst students made the all-rounders list, gaining Band 6 marks in 10 or more units of study and two placings in the top achievers list puts Daniella and Angelina in the Top 10 in the state for their subject.

A total of 93 students, out of a year group made up of 156 girls, had a total of 238 mentions on the distinguished achievers list, meaning they gained a Band 6 result in a subject.

In 34 subjects that were offered at the school, one subject was more than 20 marks over the state mean, 14 were more than 10 marks over the state mean and 23 were more

than five marks over the state mean.

An estimated 19 per cent of students attained an ATAR above 95; 39 per cent above 90; and 73 per cent above 80.

Loreto Normanhurst students also achieved four On-Stage nominations for their work in drama, one nomination for Encore for their work in music, two nominations for ArtExpress for their work in art, as well as

an impressive seven nominations for TAS for Shape for work in Design and Technology.

The excellent results rank Loreto Normanhurst 46th in the state and the top fifth Catholic school.

New principal Marina Ugonotti said it was a "privilege to lead a community such as ours and I look forward to the joy and challenges of nurturing young women".
